Basic Catholic Prayers to Be Learned

When teaching prayers & helping your children to commit them to memory, it is recommended that any confusion about which prayer forms should be taught be resolved in favor of the forms found below.

Sign of the Cross

(Finish K/1st Grade)

+ In the name of the Father, & of the Son & of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Our Father

(Finish K/1st Grade)

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread;

and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; & lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Hail Mary (Finish K/1st Grade)

Hail Mary, full of grace! The Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, & blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now & at the hour of our death. Amen.

Glory Be

(Finish K/1st Grade)

Glory be to the Father, & to the Son, & to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, & ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Grace Before Meals

(Finish K/1st Grade)

Bless us, O Lord, & these Thy gifts, which we are about to receive from Thy bounty, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Grace After Meals

(Finish K/1st Grade)

We give Thee thanks for all Thy benefits, Almighty God, who lives & reigns forever; & may the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

Act of Contrition

(Finish 2nd Grade)

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee; & I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of heaven & the pains of hell, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, who art all good & deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance & to amend my life. Amen.

Act of Contrition

(Finish 2nd Grade)

Alternate Form

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong & failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, & to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered & died for us. In His name, my God, have mercy. Amen.

Prayer to the Guardian Angel

(Finish 2nd)

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here; ever this day be at my side, to light & guard, to rule & guide. Amen.

Responses at Mass

(Finish 2nd Grade)

Take an old missalette home.

Prayer for the Poor Souls in Purgatory

(3rd)

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, & let perpetual light shine upon them.

May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

O my God, relying on Your almighty power & infinite mercy & promises, I hope to obtain pardon of my sins, the help of Your grace, & life everlasting, through the merits of Jesus Christ, my Lord & Redeemer. Amen.

Act of Love (Finish 4th Grade)

O my God, I love You above all things, with my whole heart & soul, because You are all-good & worthy of all my love. I love my neighbor as myself for love of You. I forgive all who have injured me, & I ask pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen.

Memorare (Finish 5th Grade)

Remember, O most gracious Virgin, Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help or sought thy intercession, was left unaided.

Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother; to thee I come, before thee I stand, sinful & sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear & answer me. Amen.

Hail Holy Queen (Finish 5th Grade)

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, hail, our life, our sweetness, & our hope! To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve! To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning & weeping in this vale of tears! Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; & after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus! O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

R: -That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

R: Because the Lord is truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray: O God, who by the resurrection of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, granted joy to the whole world: grant, we beg You, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may lay hold of the joys of eternal life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
